LANDORA BOAT VARNISH

Landora Boat Varnish is suitable for all woodwork in new and and old boats. Landora Boat Varnish has a water-repellent and weather-resistant finish that is resistant to cracking. Landora Boat Varnish may also be used indoors, for example on door sills or other surfaces where a durable surface is desirable.

Environmental considerations: Surplus varnish is not to be disposed of in common drains. This material and its container must be disposed of as hazardous waste.

Directions for use

Stir thoroughly before use.

- **1**. Sand the surface using a coarse grade paper. Scrape off any loose varnish and wipe the surface with a damp cloth.
- **2.** At the first application the varnish should be diluted with 15-25% Landora Odorless Mineral Spirit. The following coats are applied using undiluted Landora Boat Varnish until the desired result is achieved.

The master painter suggests: Do not work in strong sunshine, and protect the varnished surface against dew until it is dry. The drying time of each coat is reduced if you only apply a thin coat each time. Several thin coats and sanding with very fine grit between each new coat will produce the best results.

Technical data:

Gloss Level: Very gloss (90). **Consumption:** approx. 10 m²/litre.

Drying time at 20°C: Dry to the touch after approx. 4 hours, sandable after approx. 24 hours.

Application: Brush, roller or spraygun.

Cleaning of tools: Landora Odorless Mineral Spirit.
